CURRENT GRANT SCHEMES

As the current government grants schemes specifically relating to Covid-19 support have come to an end there are potentially two new schemes available to aid our recovery-

Growth & Innovation Fund

Part of the wider UK Community Renewal Fund and a business grants programme operating exclusively within the Burnley, Pendle and Rossendale corridor, identified as three of the priority areas of Lancashire.

The fund is aligned with the CRF priority of 'investment for local business' and will pilot a series of activities which will address local business and innovation needs.

We are still awaiting on whether we have been awarded this fund and will keep you informed of any developments in the near future.

Internationalisation/Export Funding



Following a meeting with Rossendale Borough Council and the Department for International Trade we have been able to obtain some fantastic resources for businesses in Rossendale looking to start or improve their export capabilities.

We now have a point of contact for all enquiries. Lynne Gillen– lynne.gillen@tradenw.org Lynne is really interested to hear what is going on in Rossendale and can offer direct support for businesses looking to export.

The Department for International Trade's Internationalisation Fund: North West

Grant funding available via new fund for eligible businesses in England.

What is the fund?

The Department for International Trade has launched its new Internationalisation Fund for eligible businesses in England. The fund is designed to support businesses looking to grow their international trade.

SMEs can apply for match-funded grants of between £1,000 and £9,000 which will be available for proposed future activities (subject to eligibility).

To secure a grant, the business will need to fund a proportion of the costs itself. This varies according to where your business is based and will be up to 50% of the total cost.

Funding is subject to availability within your region, and will be prioritised for businesses who can demonstrate they have high export potential.

Eligible Activity

The fund can be used to support areas including but not limited to:

- PR
- Market Research
- Consultancy on IPR
- Translation / Cultural Advice
- Social Media and SEO
- Participation in trade shows
- Market development including visits
- Routes to Market
- Overseas Business Environment / Due Diligence

MARL PITS RUNNING TRACK- CAN YOUR BUSINESS HELP?



A fundraising campaign has been launched to upgrade an important Valley running track.

Marl Pits running track in Rawtenstall needs £225k worth of work to upgrade its 400m cinder track after it was declared not fit for purpose.

Rossendale Harriers, Rossendale Triathlon Club, Rossendale Leisure Trust and special needs sports club, Rossendale Rays have joined forces to raise the money needed to replace the facility with a more suitable all-weather rubberised tartan-track.

Leader of Rossendale Council Councillor Alyson Barnes said: "We are aware of the situation at Marl Pits and are supportive of what is being done; we really want to see this happen and as a council we are happy to work with the community groups to achieve the goal of improving the running track.

Rossendale's cultural gem, The Whitaker Museum, reopened its doors on Saturday 24 July after a significant £2.2 million investment, including grants from the National Heritage Lottery Fund and Rossendale Borough Council.

HASLINGDEN-TRANFORMING THE TOWN CENTRE

The go-ahead has been given for a £2.5 million transformation of the town centre, in the hope of creating a brighter shopper and visitor attraction for Haslingden.

Haslingden's 2040 bid recently won the backing of the National Heritage Lottery Fund with work on a variety of improvements set to begin. Funding will also be available for business owners and landlords to refurbish and repurpose buildings in the centre.

Rossendale Council leader Alyson Barnes, chair of the Haslingden town centre strategic partnership board, said:

"The key to the success of the Haslingden 2040 bid was that it had the support of the whole community and it was developed with the backing of a number of different stakeholders. The project includes building restoration works to Upper Deardengate, the repurposing of 5-7 Deardengate, a new public realm by the 'big lamp' for public events and a micro grant events programme."

All of us at the Council would like to thank those involved in bringing this project to life and look forward to seeing the changes it will make in the future.
