Nick represents the borough as an elected member of Rossendale Borough Council for Hareholme and Waterfoot wards since 2024, currently serving as the Cabinet lead for Economic Development and a board member. With a background that began in community work in inner-city Manchester, Nick later managed mental health and learning disability services, often focusing on housing.
